



## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY - 2022

There are no particular entry or experience requirements for the Wild Earth Coastal High, however you must be at least 15 years of age on the day of the event to enter The Crunch (28km) and 18 years of age to enter the Coastal High 50.

It is your responsibility to ensure that you are fit enough to complete the event and that you are able to meet the overall course cut-off time of 10.5 hours (50)/6 hours (Crunch). Note that the event organisers reserve the right to revise the course cut-off time at any stage prior to or during the event, with particular consideration given to participants and on-course safety. There will be intermediate cut-offs at each checkpoint based on even splits for your cut offs run and you will be withdrawn from the race should you fail to meet these cut-off times. If you are withdrawn from the event by event staff, volunteers, first aid or emergency personnel the decision is final and no discussion will be entered into.

Ensure that leading into the event you are fit and healthy and that you do not have any illness that will affect your ability to complete the event. It is your responsibility to monitor your health and condition during the event and to withdraw from the event if you are no longer fit enough to continue.

The course is tough and technical in parts, with remote sections that will result in slow first aid/rescue response times if the unfortunate were to happen and your extraction from the course was required.

At the time of registration you will be required to read and agree to a Participant Waiver. A copy of this form can be accessed on the event website.

During the registration process you will be asked to select an estimated finishing time to assist us in allocating your starting wave. Please be honest and conservative when selecting your time. Finish times will automatically be adjusted to your individual wave start time.

**INSURANCE** The organisers of the Event, Coastal Events Holdings T/A Trail Trips & Events, have public liability insurance cover. This does not include personal accident insurance for competitors. We recommend that you arrange your own personal accident insurance and ambulance cover before participating in the Event to cover any unforeseen personal costs you may incur due to ambulance trips, medical expenses or time off work due to





injuries sustained whilst participating in the Event.

**LATE ENTRY POLICY** No entries will be accepted after closure of online entries (date as outlined on the event website, unless sold out prior). There are no offline entries and there are no exceptions.

**EVENT POSTPONEMENT/CANCELLATION** In the event that the Event course is, in the opinion of the event organisers, unsafe (e.g heavy rain, high winds, bushfires, "acts of god" etc), or at the direction of the land managers or any other relevant authority (e.g covid), organisers may be required to cancel the event. If the event is cancelled due to circumstances beyond the control of the event organisers, the organisers will attempt to provide some compensation to entrants, including a potential virtual option.

There are however, no guarantees as to the extent of this compensation due to costs incurred prior to cancellation. No responsibility is assumed or taken by the organisers for lost travel or accommodation expenses, or for part or full loss of entry fees paid.
